Things to Remember this Summer

- ✓ Weather appropriate coats, jackets, sun hats, shoes/ welly boots.
- ✓ Please name all items, and please ensure your child wears old clothes to nursery, as we will be continuing lots of craft activities and messy play.
- ✓ We do supply suncream, however if your child has an allergy to some creams, please provide your own with their name on and the date it was opened so we can use that instead
- ✓ Please notify the team if your child has medication or snacks in their bag

Sickness Policy

Due to an alarming number of spots over winter we have made the decision to ask you not to send your child into nursery if they have any rashes or weeping spots. Impetigo, Hand foot and mouth and Chicken Pox all display similar symptoms so if your child has any of these please keep them at home until the spots have dried. If your child requires antibiotics, we ask that they are on the course for at least 48 hours before returning to nursery as this is when the risk of an allergic reaction is highest. An allergic reaction can happen even if they have had the medication before.
